# 1 Introduction

This font and package provides support for the "frimurer" (Danish for *freemason*) cipher. It's mainly sopposed to be used with the Danish language, hence only the Danish characters are supported.

If this is not quite what You are looking for have a look at the pigpen package instead. It provides support for a different variation of the cipher.

## 2 Usage

#### 2.1 Loading the package

Load the package by typing

\usepackage{frimurer}

into your preamble.

## 2.2 Writing with the cipher

The primary way to use the font is the 'frimurer' environment.

yielding the input text in the frimurer cipher:
