





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1 Loading, useful packages, purposes and acknowledgments

1.1 Loading and useful packages

In order to load tikz-triminos, simply use:

```
\usepackage{tikz-triminos}
```

1.2 Purposes and acknowledgments

The purposes of this small package is to provide simple tool to create TriMinos (1 or 9 or 12) with automatic positionning of texts.

2 Usage

2.1 Main macro

In order to create (single or multiple) TriMinos, simple use:

```
\tkztriminos[keys]<tikz options>\{list of values\}
```


For list of values argument (seperated with §):

- 3 values can be given (so 1 TriMino) ;
- 19 values can be given (so 9 TriMinos, with 5 *jokers*) ;
- 25 values can be given (so 12 TriMinos, with 10 *jokers*) ;
- 36 values can be given (so 12 full TriMinos).

Moreover:

- if the text is too long for the TriMino, the code adjusts its width ;
- icons of graphicx elements can be used ;
- with *jokers*, the final value is the *joker*.

2.2 TikZ styles

Few TikZ styles are available, and they can be modified.

```
%sides of TriMino
\tikzset{tkztriminosome/.style={thick}}


%labels (with \tkztriminofont given by key)
\tikzset{tkztriminolabel/.style={font=\tkztriminofont,inner sep=1pt}}


%decoration (with \tkztriminocolor given by key)
\tikzset{tkztriminosidedeco/.style={semithick,draw=black,fill=\tkztriminocolor}}
```

2.3 Keys


Available keys, to be given within [...] are:

- `size` := size of `TriMino` (default 5cm)
- `font` := font for texts (default \Large)
- `decoration` := boolean for showing the *inner* decoration (default true)
- `decocolor` := color of the optional *inner* decoration (default lightgray)
- `showtxtlogo` := boolean for showing optional circular logo text (default false)
- `txtlogo` := text for optional circular logo (default TriMino~TriMino~TriMino~)
- `fontdeco` := font for optional circular logo (default \tiny\sffamily)
- `showiconlogo` := boolean for showing optional graphic logo (default false)
- `iconlogo` := graphic element for center logo
- `bgcolor` := optional background color of `TriMino`
- `scaledeco` := scale for *inner* decoration (default 0.25)






