1 Introduction

The soul package provides the \hl command for highlighting text; unfortunately this packages does not work in right to left documents.

The bidihl package allows users to highlight text in both right to left and left to right directions; it needs the bidi package and should always be loaded before bidi package.

2 Basic usage

Highlights the text. The default highlighting box color is yellow; if a different color is desired, then simply define a new color with **bidihlcolor** as the name of the color; i.e.
